## Summit Overview

Nigeria is faced with enormous socio-economic and political challenges. Nevertheless, the country's tech ecosystem has become the most attractive for the biggest global venture capital funds. Four Nigeria-based firms, Interswitch, Flutterwave, Opay, and Andela, have achieved unicorn status after exceeding valuations of \$1 billion. Technology has enhanced communication during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and improved service delivery. But it also poses substantial negative disruptive risks for various industries and regulators. Handling these risks effectively is critical for market stability, business and economic growth, sustainable resilience, optimizing opportunities and achieving corporate goals. Organizations in the public and private sectors that must achieve their goals and create long-term value amid disruptive technological change require optimal risk governance and leadership.

The understanding and application of risk governance and leadership concept is a crucial competency for Nigerian businesses, government departments and not-for-profit organizations that are striving to use technology to drive performance and efficiency, in a post-covid world. To help business and political leaders, and other stakeholders in leveraging technology to improve decision-making process and optimize business goals, the 2022 Nigerian Risk Awards and Summit (NRA) will be exploring:

1. the challenges and opportunities that technological disruption poses for organizations;
2. the impact of regulation on private investment in technology and,
3. the tools for handling technology risks in business and government.

This year's NRA is the 6th in the series, following five successful editions we have held over the past eight years. The NRA will also recognize and reward organizations and individuals who have achieved measurable results through the effective implementation of good governance, internal controls and risk management systems.

## Summit Objectives:

The summit will address the following:

- Support business leaders and public officials with the tools for improving decision-making and enhancing collaborative leadership
- Engage participants on how Nigeria can leapfrog to the Fourth Industrial Revolution to empower citizens and become more competitive.
- Assess the challenges and opportunities of digital transformation on business and governance.
- Provide tools for managing technological disruption to create new markets and expand opportunities
- Provide practical knowledge on how organizations (private and public) can leverage digital technologies to accelerate innovation, increase resilience and boost performance.

- Discuss how to manage and optimize the changing landscape of work as caused by Covid-19 shocks, demographic shifts and new technologies.

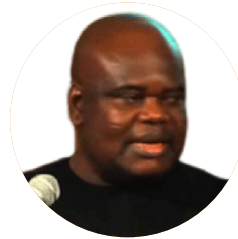
